Amigurumi Snow White

Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn in the following colors:
 - Cream, blue, light blue, yellow, red, white and black
- Size D/3-3.25mm hook
- 2 6mm safety eyes
- POLY-FIL Fiber (100% Polyester Fiberfill) “stuffing”
- Yarn Needle

Head

Rnd 1: In cream, make a Magic Circle. Work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle and ch 1. Join to beginning of the round with a slip stitch and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 3: *sc increase, sc* – repeat around. Join and ch 1. (18)

Rnd 4: *sc increase, 2 sc* – repeat around. Join & ch 1. (24)

Rnds 5-8: Work 1 sc in each st around. Join & ch 1. (24)

Rnd 9: *sc decrease, 2 sc* – repeat around. Join & ch 1. (18)

Rnd 10: *sc decrease, sc* – repeat around. Join & ch 1. (12)

Insert the safety eyes into round 7, placing them two full stitches apart. See photos for reference if necessary. Carefully stuff the head, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 11: *sc decrease* – repeat around. Join & ch 1. (6)

Rnd 12: Work 1 sc in each st around. Join and ch 1. (6)

Continue onto the body.

Body

Rnd 13: *sc increase* - repeat around. Switch to white, join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 14: In white, *4 sc, sc increase* - repeat twice. 2 sc. Join, change to blue and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 15: In blue, *4 sc, sc increase* - repeat twice. 4 sc. Join and ch 1. (16)

Rnd 16: *sc decrease* – repeat around. Join, change to yellow and ch 1. (8)

Rnd 17: In yellow, *sc increase* – repeat around. Join and ch 1. (16)

Rnd 18: *sc increase, 5 sc* – repeat twice. sc increase, 3 sc. Join and ch 1. (19)

Rnds 19-23: 19 sc. Join and ch 1. (19)

Rnd 24: 19 sc. Join, change to white and ch 1. (19)

Rnd 25: In white, working in the *front* loops only, *sc increase, 2 sc* – repeat six times. sc in last st. Join to first st of round and fasten off. (25)

Rnd 26: With yellow, insert your hook into the *back* loop of the first st of rnd 24. Ch 1. Working in the *back* loops only, 19 sc. Join and ch 1. (19)

Rnd 27: *sc decrease, 2 sc* – repeat four times. sc decrease, 2 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Using your crochet hook, pull up a tiny bit of the stuffing from the head into the neck (this is easier than trying to force stuffing into the neck). Carefully stuff the rest of the body, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 28: *sc decrease* – repeat around. Join and ch 1. (7)



Rnd 29: *sc2tog* – repeat three times. sc. Fasten off. (4)

Use a yarn needle to sew closed the remaining gap in the circle and weave in ends.

Arms & Sleeves (Make 2)

Rnd 1: In cream, make a Magic Circle. Work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle and ch 1. Join to beginning of the round with a slip stitch and ch 1. (6)

Rnds 2-3: 6 sc. Join and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 4: 6 sc. Join, change to light blue & ch 1. (6)

Rnd 5: In light blue, *sc increase* - repeat around. Join & ch 1 (12 sts)

Carefully stuff the top of the sleeve just a little bit. It helps to roll the fluff between your hands to make it fit into the sleeve.

Rnd 6: *sc decrease* – repeat around. Join and fasten off.

Use a yarn needle to sew closed the remaining hole at the top of the arm. Sew to body just below the white trim/neckline of the dress. See photos for placement. Weave in ends.

Hair

Rnd 1: In black, make a Magic Circle. Work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to beginning of the round with a slip stitch and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2: *sc increase* - repeat around. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 3: *sc increase, sc* – repeat around. Join and ch 1. (18)

Rnd 4: *sc increase, 2 sc* – repeat around. Join & ch 1. (24)

Rnds 5-6: 24 sc. Join & ch 1. (24)

Rnd 7: *work 3 hdc in next st, then sl st in next st* – repeat 5 times. Ch 1. *work 4 dc in next st, then sl st in next st* – repeat 5 times. sl st in last st. Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Use a tapestry needle to sew the hair piece to the doll's head so that the smaller "bumps" along the edge are in the front like bangs and the larger "bumps" go around the rest of the back of the head. Weave in ends.



Red Sleeve Trim:

Using a yarn needle and a strand of red yarn approximately 8" long, weave in the red decorative stitches for the sleeves. See photos for placement if needed. Sew the arms to the body just below the white trim/neckline of the dress. See photos for placement. Weave in ends.

Headband

Rnd 1: In red, ch 15. Fasten off. (15)

Use a tapestry needle to sew to head. See photos for placement.

Bow

Rnd 1: In red, ch 7. Starting in the 2nd chain space from hook, sc across. Ch 1 and turn. (6)

Rnd 2: sc across. Fasten off.

Using a long strand of red yarn, wrap around the center of the bow to tighten and synch the center of the bow. Tie the yarn strand tight and sew to headband. Weave in ends.



Makeup Details

For the “eyelashes”, take a strand of 4-ply yarn in black and carefully split the yarn in half, making two 2-ply strands. Use a needle to carefully embroider the “eyelashes” on the outsides of both eyes. Repeat using a strand of blue yarn for the “eyeshadow”. Weave in all ends.

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Love your Snow White doll?

To care for your doll, spot-clean with warm water and a washcloth or, if necessary, she can be soaked in warm soapy water and patted dry.

Do not wring or squeeze your doll dry as that can damage the yarn!
