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# PATTERN NOTES

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## STITCH KEY

ch – chain

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half-double crochet

dc – double crochet

sc inc – single crochet increase

sc dec – single crochet decrease

\* \* - complete instructions between the \* for the total number of times indicated

## YARN AND HOOK SIZE

I recommend using a size D/3.25mm hook.

I recommend worsted- or aran-weight yarn in these colors:  
beige, white, black, dark red, dark green, blue, camel, brown, medium brown

## CONTINUOUS ROUNDS VS. JOINING

If desired, you can work these patterns in continuous rounds, rather than joining.

The instructions are written for joining, but feel free to use the method you are most comfortable with!

## OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Polyester Fiberfill Stuffing (available at any local craft store)

Plastic Safety Eyes, 6mm, black (2 per doll)

Yarn needle (for sewing in ends)

# DEAN WINCHESTER

## Head

Rnd 1) In BEIGE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2) \*sc inc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 3) \*sc inc, sc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (18)

Rnds 4-7) 18 sc. Join and ch 1. (18)

Insert the eyes into the 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> stitches of round 5, so that there are 3 sc stitches between the eyes.

Rnd 8) \*sc dec, sc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Carefully stuff the head, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 9) \*sc dec\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 10) 6 sc. Change to BLACK. Join and ch 1. (6)

## Body

Rnd 11) In BLACK, \*sc inc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 12) \*4 sc, sc inc\* - repeat 2 times, then 2 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnds 13-14) 14 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 15) \*4 sc, sc inc\* - repeat 2 times, then sc inc, 3 sc. Change to BLUE, join and ch 1. (17)

Rnds 16-17) In BLUE, 17 sc. Join and ch 1. (17)

Rnd 18) In BACK LOOPS ONLY, \*sc dec, sc\* - repeat 5 times, then sc dec. Join and ch 1. (11)

Carefully stuff the body, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 19) In BOTH LOOPS, \*sc dec\* - repeat 5 times, then sc. Join and fasten off. (6)

### Arms (Make 2)

Rnd 1) In BEIGE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 5 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 2) 5 sc. Change to MEDIUM BROWN. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 3) In MEDIUM BROWN, 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 4) 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 5) 5 sc. Join and fasten off.

If desired, you can stuff the arms. If you find it makes them a bit too bulky, leave it out.

### Hair

Rnd 1) In BROWN, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 7 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (7)

Rnd 2) \*sc inc\* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 3) \*sc inc, sc\* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (21)

Rnds 4-6) 21 sc. Join and ch 1. (21)

TIP: Try this hair piece on the doll as you go. If at round 4 (or 5) you think that the hair piece fits okay, skip round 5 (or 6) and continue. Depending on your tension, your hair piece might be too long if you complete all of rounds 4-6. Skipping one or two rounds will shorten the piece.

Rnd 7) 7 sc, hdc, 3 dc inc, hdc, sl st, hdc, 7 sc. Fasten off. (24)

Use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to carefully sew the hair piece onto the doll's head. Weave in ends.

### Jacket

Row 1) In MEDIUM BROWN, ch 15. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, 14 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (14)

Rows 2-3) 14 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (14)

Row 4) hdc dec, hdc, ch 2, skip next 2 sts, 4 hdc, ch 2, skip next 2 sts, hdc, hdc dec. Ch 1 and turn. (12)

Row 5) sc dec, 8 sc, sc dec. Fasten off and weave in ends. (10)

Use a strand of yarn in MEDIUM BROWN and a yarn needle to sew the piece onto the doll's body so that it cannot be removed. Weave in ends.

### Finishing Steps

Use the tail end of the yarn and a yarn needle to sew closed the opening at the base of the body.

Use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to carefully sew the arms onto the body between rounds 11 and 12.

Weave in all ends for the head, body and arms of the doll.

Use a strand of BROWN yarn and a yarn needle to embroider on eyebrows.

# SAM WINCHESTER

## Head

Rnd 1) In BEIGE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2) \*sc inc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 3) \*sc inc, sc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (18)

Rnds 4-7) 18 sc. Join and ch 1. (18)

Insert the eyes into the 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> stitches of round 5, so that there are 3 sc stitches between the eyes.

Rnd 8) \*sc dec, sc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Carefully stuff the head, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 9) \*sc dec\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 10) 6 sc. Change to DARK RED. Join and ch 1. (6)

## Body

Rnd 11) In DARK RED, \*sc inc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 12) \*4 sc, sc inc\* - repeat 2 times, then 2 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnds 13-15) 14 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 16) \*4 sc, sc inc\* - repeat 2 times, then sc inc, 3 sc. Change to BLUE, join and ch 1. (17)

Rnds 17-18) In BLUE, 17 sc. Join and ch 1. (17)

Rnd 19) In BACK LOOPS ONLY, \*sc dec, sc\* - repeat 5 times, then sc dec. Join and ch 1. (11)

Carefully stuff the body, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 20) In BOTH LOOPS, \*sc dec\* - repeat 5 times, then sc. Join and fasten off. (6)

### Arms (Make 2)

Rnd 1) In BEIGE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 5 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 2) 5 sc. Change to DARK GREEN. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 3) In DARK GREEN, 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 4) 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 5) 5 sc. Join and fasten off.

If desired, you can stuff the arms. If you find it makes them a bit too bulky, leave it out.

### Hair

Rnd 1) In BROWN, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 7 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (7)

Rnd 2) \*sc inc\* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 3) \*sc inc, sc\* - repeat 7 times. Join, but do not ch 1. (21)

From this point forward, you will make a series of 11 chains: 4 long, 1 medium, 5 short, and 1 medium.

Chains 1-4) ch 5. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, work 4 sc down the chain. Join to rnd 3 with a sl st in the stitch that is *right next to* the start of the chain. Sl st in next st. (4)

Chain 5) ch 4. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, work 3 sc down the chain. Join to rnd 3 with a sl st in the stitch that is *right next to* the start of the chain. Sl st in nex st. (3)

Chains 6-10) ch 3. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, work 2 sc down the chain. Join to rnd 3 with a sl st in the stitch that is *right next to* the start of the chain. Sl st in next st. (2)

Chain 11) ch 4. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, work 3 sc down the chain. Join to rnd 3 with a sl st in the stitch that is *right next to* the start of the chain. Fasten off. (3)

Position the hair piece so that the 5 short chains (chains #6-10) are at the front of the doll's face (the longer chains will be at the back of the doll's head).

Using the tail end of the yarn and a yarn needle, carefully sew the hair piece to the doll's head. Weave in ends.

### Jacket

Row 1) In DARK GREEN, ch 15. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, 14 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (14)

Rows 2-3) 14 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (14)

Row 4) hdc dec, hdc, ch 2, skip next 2 sts, 4 hdc, ch 2, skip next 2 sts, hdc, hdc dec. Ch 1 and turn. (12)

Row 5) sc dec, 8 sc, sc dec. Fasten off and weave in ends. (10)

Use a strand of yarn in DARK GREEN and a yarn needle to sew the piece onto the doll's body so that it cannot be removed. Weave in ends.

### Finishing Steps

Use the tail end of the yarn and a yarn needle to sew closed the opening at the base of the body.

Use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to carefully sew the arms onto the body between rounds 11 and 12.

Weave in all ends for the head, body and arms of the doll.

Use a strand of MEDIUM BROWN yarn and a yarn needle to embroider on eyebrows.



# CASTIEL

## Head

Rnd 1) In BEIGE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2) \*sc inc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 3) \*sc inc, sc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (18)

Rnds 4-7) 18 sc. Join and ch 1. (18)

Insert the eyes into the 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> stitches of round 5, so that there are 3 sc stitches between the eyes.

Rnd 8) \*sc dec, sc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Carefully stuff the head, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 9) \*sc dec\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 10) 6 sc. Change to WHITE. Join and ch 1. (6)

## Body

Rnd 11) In WHITE, \*sc inc\* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 12) \*4 sc, sc inc\* - repeat 2 times, then 2 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnds 13-14) 14 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 15) \*4 sc, sc inc\* - repeat 2 times, then sc inc, 3 sc. Change to BLACK, join and ch 1. (17)

Rnds 16-17) In BLACK, 17 sc. Join and ch 1. (17)

Rnd 18) In BACK LOOPS ONLY, \*sc dec, sc\* - repeat 5 times, then sc dec. Join and ch 1. (11)

Carefully stuff the body, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 19) In BOTH LOOPS, \*sc dec\* - repeat 5 times, then sc. Join and fasten off. (6)

### Arms (Make 2)

Rnd 1) In BEIGE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 5 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 2) 5 sc. Change to CAMEL. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 3) In CAMEL, 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 4) 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 5) 5 sc. Join and fasten off.

If desired, you can stuff the arms. If you find it makes them a bit too bulky, leave it out.

### Hair

Rnd 1) In MEDIUM BROWN, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 7 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (7)

Rnd 2) \*sc inc\* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 3) \*sc inc, sc\* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (21)

Rnds 4-6) 21 sc. Join and ch 1. (21)

TIP: Try this hair piece on the doll as you go. If at round 4 (or 5) you think that the hair piece fits okay, skip round 5 (or 6) and continue. Depending on your tension, your hair piece might be too long if you complete all of rounds 4-6. Skipping one or two rounds will shorten the piece.

Rnd 7) 7 sc, hdc, sl st, sc, sc inc, sc, sl st, hdc, 7 sc. Fasten off. (22)

Use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to carefully sew the hair piece onto the doll's head. Weave in ends.

### Jacket

Row 1) In CAMEL, ch 15. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, 14 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (14)

Rows 2-5) 14 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (14)

Row 6) hdc dec, hdc, ch 2, skip next 2 sts, 4 hdc, ch 2, skip next 2 sts, hdc, hdc dec. Ch 1 and turn. (12)

Row 7) sc dec, 8 sc, sc dec. Fasten off and weave in ends. (10)

Use a strand of yarn in CAMEL and a yarn needle to sew the piece onto the doll's body so that it cannot be removed. Weave in ends.

### Wings (Make 2)

Row 1) In BLACK, ch 7. Starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain space from the hook, 6 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (6)

From this point forwards, work in the BACK LOOPS ONLY for the wings.

Row 2) 5 sc. Skip the last st of the row. Ch 1 and turn. (5)

Row 3) 5 sc. Ch 1 and turn. (5)

Row 4) 4 sc. Skip the last st of the row. Ch 1 and turn. (4)

Row 5) 4 sc. Do not turn! (4)

At this point, you will be crocheting up the inside side of the wing (the side of the wing that will meet the other wing).

Row 6) 2 sc dec. Ch 1 and turn. (2)

Row 7) sc dec. Fasten off.

When both wings are made, use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to carefully sew the wings to the back of the doll. Weave in ends.

### Finishing Steps

Use the tail end of the yarn and a yarn needle to sew closed the opening at the base of the body.

Use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to carefully sew the arms onto the body between rounds 11 and 12.

Weave in all ends for the head, body and arms of the doll.

Use a strand of BROWN yarn and a yarn needle to embroider on eyebrows.

Use a strand of BLACK or BLUE yarn and a yarn needle to embroider on the tie.
