



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Pattern Notes

Stitch Key

ch – chain

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half-double crochet

dc – double crochet

trc – treble crochet

inc – increase (ex: single crochet inc = sc inc)

dec – decrease (ex: single crochet dec = sc dec)

tog – together (ex: 3 sctog = crochet 3 sc in same st)

* * - complete instructions between the * for the total number of times indicated

Yarn and Hook Size

I recommend using a size D/3.25mm hook.

I recommend worsted- or aran-weight yarn in these colors:
skin tone, black, turquoise, blue (use gold yarn or embroidery floss)

Continuous Rounds vs. Joining

If desired, you can work these patterns in continuous rounds, rather than joining.

The instructions are written for joining, but feel free to use the method you are most comfortable with!

Other Materials Needed

Polyester Fiberfill Stuffing (available at any local craft store)

Plastic Safety Eyes, 6mm, black (2 per doll)

Yarn needle (for sewing in ends)

Embroidery floss and/or crochet thread, black (plus gold embroidery floss or yarn)

Head

Rnd 1) In SKIN TONE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2) *sc inc* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 3) *sc inc, sc* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (18)

Rnds 4-7) 18 sc. Join and ch 1. (18)

Insert the eyes into the 8th and 12th stitches of round 5, so that there are 3 sc stitches between the eyes.

Rnd 8) *sc dec, sc* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Carefully stuff the head, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 9) *sc dec* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 10) 6 sc. Join and ch 1. (6)

Body

Rnd 11) *sc inc* - repeat 6 times. Join and ch 1. (12)

Rnd 12) *4 sc, sc inc* - repeat 2 times, then 2 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 13) 14 sc. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 14) 14 sc. Change to TURQUOISE, join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 15) In TURQUOISE, *4 sc, sc inc* - repeat 2 times, then sc inc, 3 sc. Join and ch 1. (17)

Rnds 16-18) 17 sc. Join and ch 1. (17)

Rnd 19) In BACK LOOPS ONLY, *sc dec, sc* - repeat 5 times, then sc dec. Join and ch 1. (11)

Carefully stuff the body, but do not overstuff!

Rnd 20) In BOTH LOOPS, *sc dec* - repeat 5 times, then sc. Join and fasten off. (6)

Use the tail end of the yarn and a yarn needle to sew closed the opening at the base of the body. Weave in ends.

Top

Row 1) In TURQUOISE, ch 20. Starting in the 2nd chain space from the hook, work 7 sl st, then sc. Work a hdc, dc inc, and hdc all in the *next* st. 2 sl st. Ch 1. Then work a hdc, dc inc, and hdc all in the *next* st. Sc in the next st, then work 7 sl st. Fasten off. (26 + 1 chain)

Sleeves (Make 2)

Row 1) In TURQUOISE, ch 10. Fasten off. (10)

Arms (Make 2)

Rnd 1) In SKIN TONE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 5 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (5)

Rnds 2-4) 5 sc. Join and ch 1. (5)

Rnd 5) 5 sc. Join and fasten off. (5)

Main Hair Piece

Rnd 1) In BLACK, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 7 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (7)

Rnd 2) *sc inc* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (14)

Rnd 3) *sc inc, sc* - repeat 7 times. Join and ch 1. (21)

Rnds 4-6) 21 sc. Join and ch 1. (21)

Rnd 7) sc, hdc, 4 dc, trc inc, dc, hdc inc, sc, sl st, sc, hdc inc, dc, trc inc, 4 dc, hdc, sc. Fasten off. (25)

Ponytail

Row 1) With BLACK, insert your hook into the 23rd st of rnd 7 of the main hair piece. Ch 1. 3 sc. Turn and ch 1. (3)

Row 2) 3 sctog. Turn and ch 1. (1)

Row 3) 3 sc in same st. Turn and ch 1. (3)
Row 4) sc inc, sc, sc inc. Turn and ch 1. (5)
Row 5) sc dec, sc, sc dec. Turn and ch 1. (3)
Row 6) 3 sctog. Turn and ch 1. (1)
Row 7) 3 sc in same st. Turn and ch 1. (3)
Row 8) sc inc, sc, sc inc. Turn and ch 1. (5)
Row 9) sc dec, sc, sc dec. Turn and ch 1. (3)
Row 10) 3 sctog. Turn and ch 1. (1)
Row 11) sc. Fasten off. (1)

Headband

Row 1) In TURQUOISE, ch 20. Fasten off.

Jewel Headband Piece

Rnd 1) In BLUE, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Change to GOLD. Join to the beginning sc of the round and ch 1. (6)

Rnd 2) In GOLD, 6 sc inc. Join and fasten off. (12)

Necklace

Row 1) In GOLD, ch 8. Starting in the 2nd chain space from the hook, work a sl st, ch 6. Fasten off. (14)

Earrings (Make 2)

Row 1) In GOLD, make a Magic Circle. Ch 1 and work 6 sc in the center of the Magic Circle. Join to the beginning sc of the round and fasten off. (6)

Finishing Steps

Use a yarn needle and the tail ends of the yarn to carefully sew the arms onto the body between rounds 11 and 12. If desired, you can stitch the openings at the tops of the arms flat before sewing the arms to the body.

Sew the top to the doll's body. Then sew on the sleeve pieces, making sure they go over the arms and meet along the band of the "top" piece in the back.

Sew the hair piece to the doll's head. If desired, carefully tie a strand of TURQUOISE yarn around each of the spots in the ponytail where the hair "bunches" together. See photos for placement if necessary.

Use the tail ends of the yarn and a yarn needle to sew the sleeve details onto the doll so that the ends of the sleeve pieces meet under the arm and at the edge of Jasmine's top. See photos for placement if necessary.

Sew the headband to the top of the doll's head. Then sew the jeweled headband piece to the front-center of the headband.

Carefully sew the earrings to either side of the doll's head.

Tie the necklace at the back of Jasmine's neck and use a yarn needle to stitch the back of the necklace down against the back of her neck and weave in ends. This keeps the necklace from moving about too much during play. You can also stitch the front of the necklace down, if you desire. Or, if you prefer, tie the necklace ends together, weave in ends, and leave the necklace free and floating.

Use a yarn needle and a strand of BLACK yarn to embroider on eyebrows.

Use a yarn needle and a strand of BLACK THREAD to embroider on eyelashes.

Weave in all ends.
